

For St. Augustine's School to succeed in fulfilling the aims of its Mission Statement, it is essential for a strong and meaningful relationship to exist between our pupils, their parents and the school.

As a Parent/Carer I agree to:

- i. Support actively the Catholic ideals of the school, as expressed in the Mission Statement and policies
- ii. Uphold and support the school's aim to promote the highest standards of attainment, discipline, behaviour and dress.

- vii. Take an interest in my child's school career and inform the school of any relevant factor which might affect my child's performance or general attitude.

- i. Achieve the aims set out in its Mission Statement.
- ii. Value each pupil as a member of God's Family.
- iii. Provide a secure environment in which learning can take place.
- iv. Provide a balanced curriculum for all pupils and tuition which aims to meet their particular needs, promote 100% attendance and support them to achieve their full potential.
- v. Report to parents 3 times a year
- vi. Hold at least one Parents' Evening annually for each year group.
- vii. Inform parents of any causes for concern at an early stage.
- viii. Send regular newsletters home, informing parents of school news and activities.

As a Pupil I agree to:

- i. Contribute to the Christian family character of the school and show respect to all members of the school community.
- ii. Work to the best of my ability both in school work and homework.
- iii. Adhere to the school rules and obey the school's Code of Conduct.
- iv. Aim for 100% attendance.
