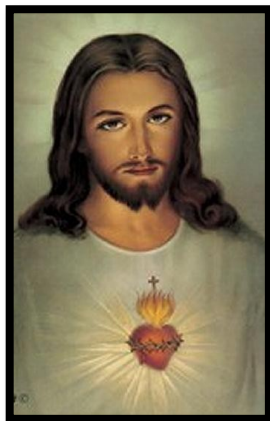
Our theme this year is
