Front of School and Pupil's Entrance

The pupils' entrance is found by going through the school gate and turning right. On the first day staff will be there to help guide you child to the right place.



School Hall

On the first day Year 7 should go straight to the school hall for their first assembly and to be welcomed to St Augustine's School. The school hall is also used as a place to eat lunch.



Main Block

Art, Music, Technology as well as PE are all taught in the school's main block. You will also find the Year 9/10 toilets here.

In this block, you will also find the Headteacher's office and the main school office as well as our prayer room and our school chaplain's office.



A Block

In A Block you will find English, Geography, History and Computer Science classrooms as well as the School Library. This is also where you will find the Year 7/8 toilets.



B Block

B Block contains classrooms for RE, Maths and Languages. This is also the location of the Year 11 toilets.



L Block

L Block is the home to our Pastoral team and the offices of our Assistant Headteachers.

There is also an extra English classrooms located here.



Science Block
